

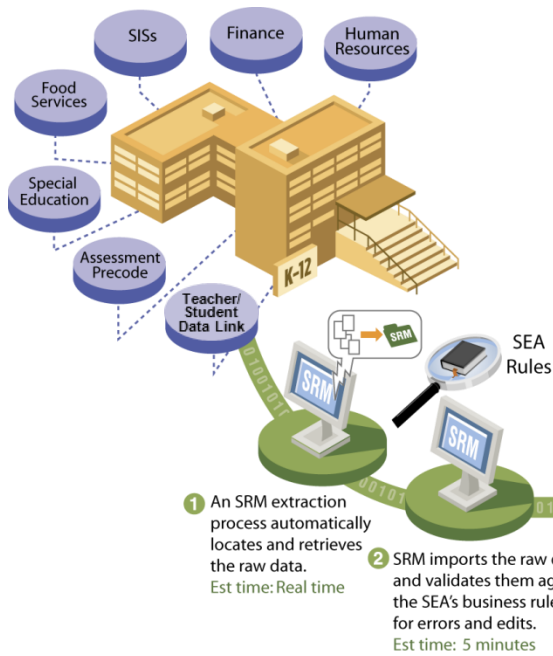

HOW IT WORKS

State Report Manager™ (SRM™) provides you with a way to ensure that your data (e.g., student, staff, district, state) meet the validation standards before you submit them officially. Before you submit your data, you must make sure that they are error-free. SRM enables you to run trials of your data against the validation rules. After you run a trial on a collection of data, you can view reports that show you any errors that were found in your data. You can correct errors and rerun trials until your data are error free. The table below is a partial catalog of collections we are actively maintaining in states that use SRM (your state may call the collections by a different name). ESP can create any type of SRM data collection based on your agency's specific needs.

PRICING
